- 1. This young man is obviously in some difficulty. Hopefully the PSR will prove helpful. He seems intensely sorry for himself. Instructing solicitors believe that he was very upset by his mother's death. He was, apparently, close to her.
- 2. Counsel will see his anxieties about his HIV status emerging; it is obviously good mitigation but his father will be at court and so sensitivity is needed.
- 3. Counsel will, of course, do his best in this case, which is far from easy.
